Intensive Global Bioethics Training Program

The program combines intensive coursework with applied, skill-oriented learning to develop participants' knowledge and skills in international research ethics.

PROGRAM INCLUDES:

- · Two separate week-long Johns Hopkins Berman *Institute Bioethics Intensive courses*
- diverse activities outside the classroom, including visits to Federal agencies in Washington, DC
- · Orientation to Johns Hopkins University and
- · One month furnished apartment
- · One month health insurance
- · All program-related local ground transportation

Program participants are enrolled in two different non-credit, week-long intensive courses: Foundations of **Bioethics and Introduction to Research** Ethics (with options to substitute other courses). Courses are taught by Berman Institute faculty from the Johns Hopkins University's world-renowned schools of Medicine, Public Health, Nursing, and Arts & Sciences.

In addition to formal coursework, program participants will interact with a diverse group of international trainees participating in the program. **GBTP** activities further include structured meetings with bioethics personnel at the US National **Institutes of Health, US Food & Drug** Administration, and the US Office for **Human Research Protections.**

Program participants will interact with key personnel from JHU Institutional Review Boards (IRBs), participate in special seminars, mock IRB sessions,



expert-led case discussions, student-led presentations, and individual or small group meetings with Berman Institute faculty to provide mentorship and guidance related to educational, career, and research goals.
